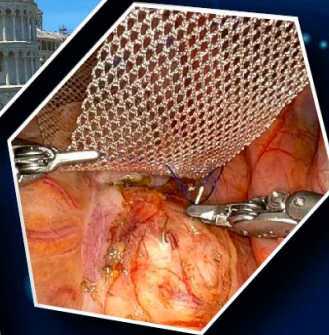

PRESENTATION

The PFC Academy School of Proctology and Pelvic Floor Diseases is dedicated to enhancing the proficiency in constructing a correct clinical framework, interpreting pre-operative tests, providing accurate surgical indications, and ultimately elevating the standard of surgery. These objectives will be achieved through the guidance of our team of highly skilled coaches.

The instructional focus will center on live surgeries broadcasted in high definition, accompanied by step-by-step discussions of surgical techniques through edited and semi-edited videos. This approach aims to dissect crucial steps and present various surgical options.

The course will also delve into the analysis of surgical indications and the management of potential complications, relying on literature to substantiate best practices.

Our program will feature a roster of Italian and International Key Opinion Leaders (KOL) who will take turns delivering lectures and participating in the operating room. While the lectures will draw from surgical literature, we will emphasize the invaluable contribution of personal insights from KOLs, enriching the experience for all participants.

The intensive 5-day course (Monday to Friday) will include live surgeries every morning, lectures, step-by-step analysis of surgical procedures using partially edited videos, a special session on anal and pelvic floor ultrasound with image processing, interpretation, and discussion, as well as the inclusion of national and international guest speakers.

TARGET AUDIENCE

This program is designed for surgeons specializing in general surgery and surgical residents with a keen interest in the study and treatment of proctological and pelvic floor diseases.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants should possess a postgraduate specialization in General Surgery or related disciplines and be residents in the final two years of General Surgery.

OBJECTIVES

- ✓ Acquire the necessary elements for correctly clinically, diagnostically, and therapeutically framing proctological diseases of the pelvic floor in a correct way.
- ✓ Analyze diagnostic examinations, discussing the indications, procedures, and interpretation of results to facilitate optimal therapeutic decision-making.
- ✓ Share surgical techniques through live surgeries and discussions of didactic videos.
- ✓ Introduce new technologies with discussions on potential advantages.
- ✓ Develop the ability to recognize and manage complications.
- ✓ Foster the concept of a multidisciplinary team for the elaboration and management of shared protocols for the treatment of complex pelvic floor pathology.
